



# Shoot Binder

The Perfection for your vineyard



The ERO Shoot Binder reduces labor intensive shoot positioning by hand to a minimum of time so that an area of 2,5 acre will be done in about 2 – 3 hours of time.

Front mounted to the tractor the Shoot Binder is attached to an over the row frame set up, hanging free on top of the row. Equipped with a break away system the Shoot Binder is moving back, if a post is hit. Two twine stables together will lift the shoots and keep them in upright position. In doing so the canapé' gets more stability and shoots sliding out will be prevented.

An electric controlled twine stop will give you the possibility of tensioning and knotting the twine from the tractor seat without leaving.

Depending on diameter, 1 bale of twine will last for 5000 – 9000 m (16.600 – 30.000 ft ) distance in the row of the vineyard.

As options available are top cutter attachment rotary knife or double knife configuration , electric or hydraulic controlled.

### Two Models:

#### Type 500:

Electric controlled Bar-stable box, hold 500 stables

#### Type 4000:

Electric controlled Spool-stable box, holds 4000 stables

### Options:

TOP Leaf Cutter, Rotary Knife, auger extension to 2,00 m / 6' 8"; hydraulic or electric driven

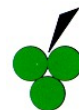

### Hydraulic set up on the Tractor:

- Two single acting hydraulic valve
- One pressure free return line in to your hydraulic oil reservoir
- One electric 12 V plug
- Hydraulic Oil flow 15 l (4 Gal.) / per minute
- Hydraulic Oil pressure min. 175 bar / 2750 PSI

### Type 4000:

Electric controlled Spool-stable box, holds 4000 stables
